This month we'll be following along with church series 'On the Road' all about the journey of discipleship.

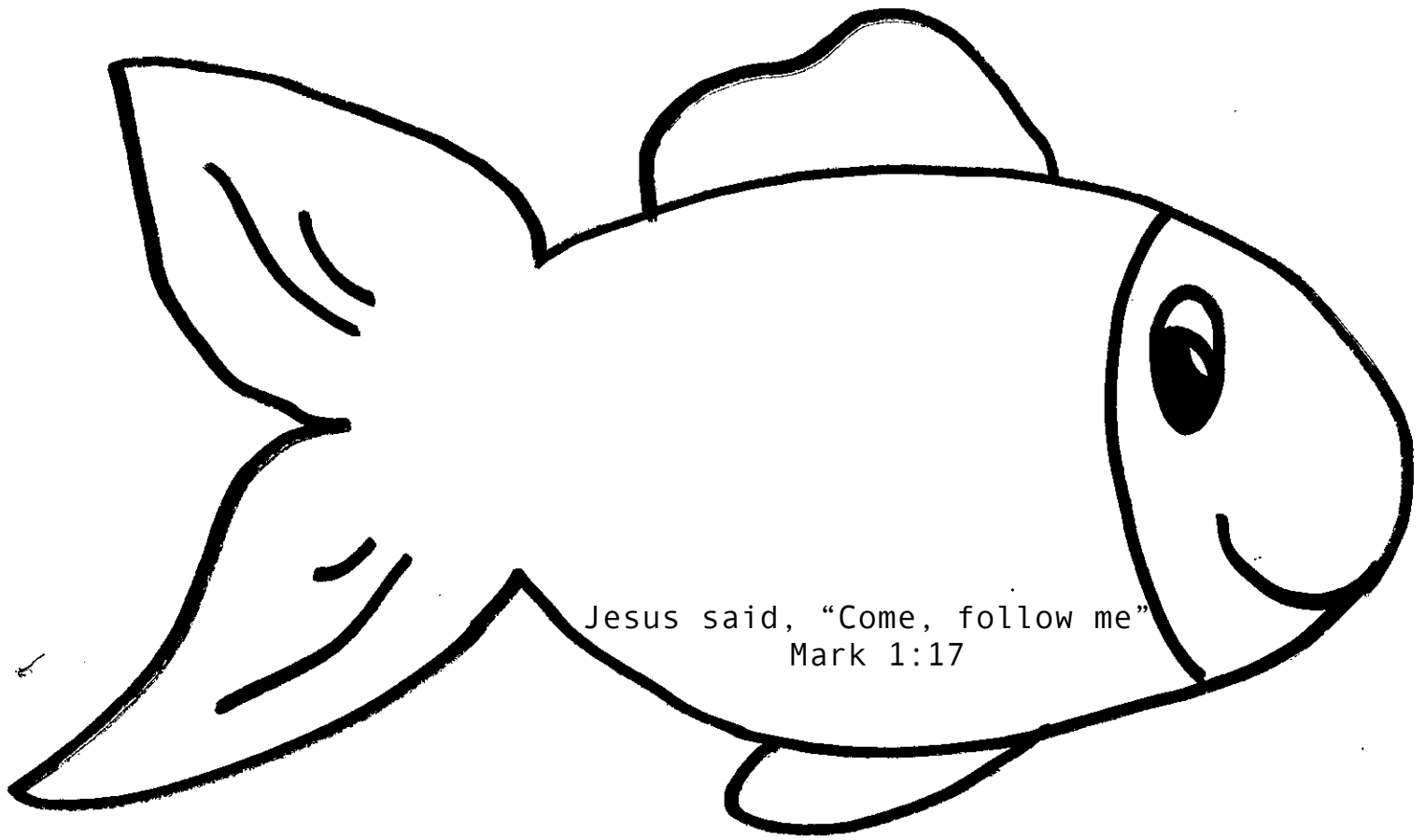
Below is an outline of the craft for the month. You can also see our focus for each week, which our hope is that you would be able to read the stories & reflect together with your kids throughout the month.

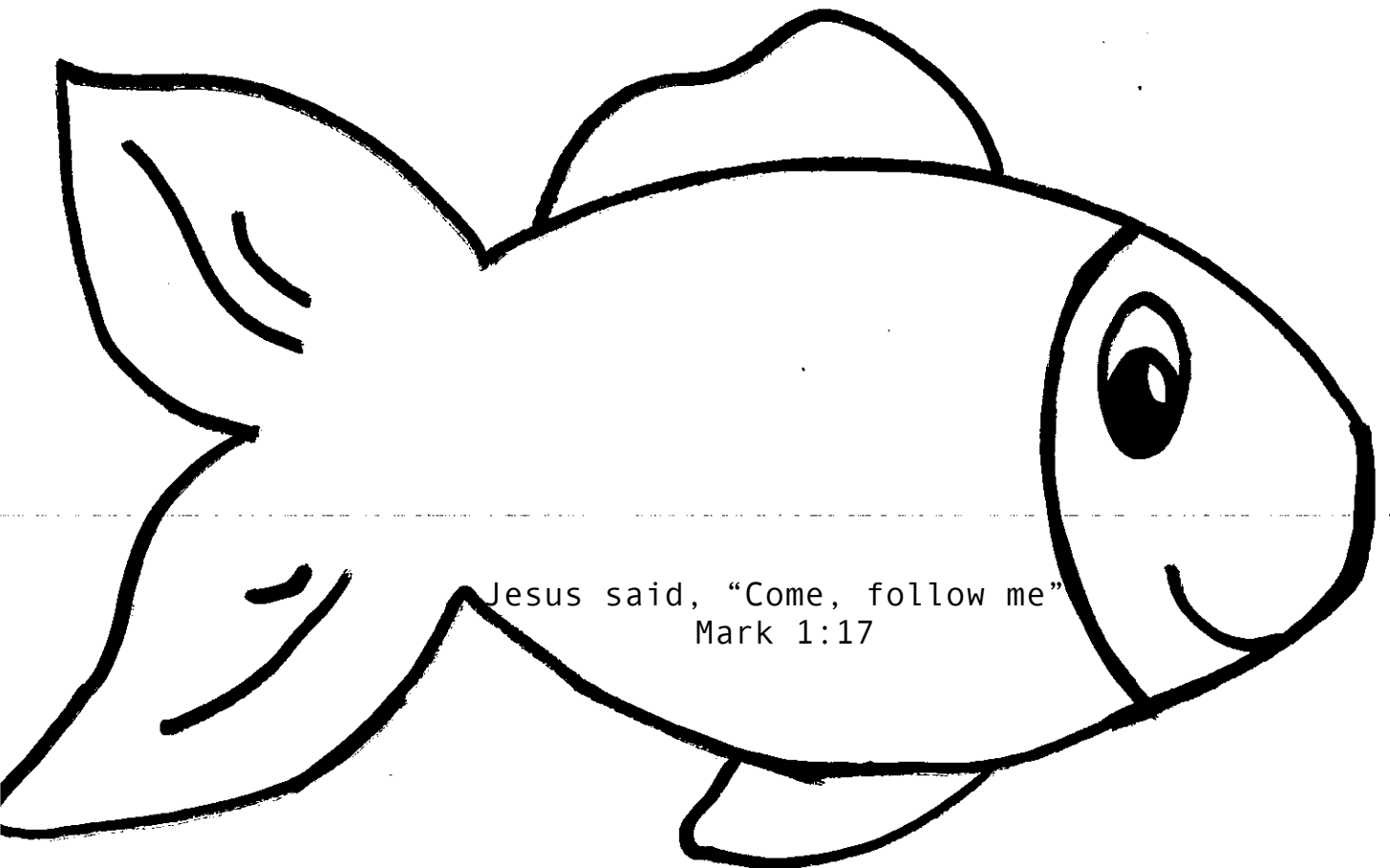

Week	Craft for each child	Instructions
07 June 2020	"Come, Follow me" Fish. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fish craft page • Coloured paper 'fish scales' • Glitter • Glue & scissors • Colouring crayons 	Jesus calls the first disciples // Jesus invites us to be His disciples. Mark 1:16-20, 2:13-17 Glue coloured paper & glitter on as scales for the fish. Talk together about how Jesus is our friend and wants to help us live our best life and that is why He asks us to follow Him. He loves us.
14 June 2020	He is the vine & we are the branches. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BYO – branch/stick • Wool • Fruit cut-out 	The Vine & the Branches // To follow Jesus we need to know Him. John 15 Have a fun adventure outside collecting your own stick. Thread the fruit cut-out onto the piece of wool. Wrap the wool around the main part of the stick as the vine. Talk together about how Jesus is the vine and by staying connected to him & knowing Him we can follow Him & produce fruit.
21 June 2020	People chain <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People chain cut-out • Tissue paper • Glue & scissors • Colouring crayons 	The Great Commission // Disciples make Disciples. Matthew 2 Fold the people cut-out along the dotted lines. Cut-out the person shape (an ADULT may need to help with this). Decorate the people to look like people you might like to tell about Jesus with the tissue paper. Talk together about who these people might be.
28 June 2020	Love one another Band-Aid. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Top Band-Aid cut-out • Bottom Band-Aid cut-out • Glue & scissors • Colouring crayons 	The Good Samaritan // Disciples LOVE God & LOVE others. Luke 10:25-37 Colour in Band-Aids. Cut the outside lines of the Band-Aid shapes (an ADULT may need to help with this). Fold top Band-Aid on dotted lines. Cut along solid line. Put glue on blank parts on bottom Band-Aid and stick top Band Aid pieces to it.
