Our craft this week can help remind us of how because we are part of God's family, nothing can separate us from His love.

Supplies

Paper
Pencils/crayons/textas & scissors and glue
Decorating stickers
Bible

1. As you're reading your bible write down or draw a picture to remind you of what God's word says. Find a verse that speaks about God's love for you. You might like to read Romans 8:14-17; 37-39 which we heard about from Blurp!
2. Fold your A4 paper in half and place your hand with your pointer finger and thumb over the edge where the fold is.
3. Trace around your hand.
4. Cut out the outline of your hand being careful not to cut the folded paper where the thumb & finger crossed it. An ADULT may need to help with this step.
5. Unfold your hands to reveal the love heart shape in the middle.
6. Decorate with the scripture &/or drawings from the bible, and any stickers or fun things you might have at home.

Prayer Sandwiches

Supplies

Bread
Sandwich spreads

1. Lay out 2 slices of bread
2. Spread butter (or another spread) on one piece
As you spread, **talk to God about yourself**. Tell Him what you are thinking and feeling.
3. Spread vegemite (or another spread) on the other piece of bread
As you spread, **talk to God about Him**. Tell Him what you love about Him and thankful for.
4. Squish your sandwich together and enjoy!

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The Closer Catch

Come close to God and God will come close to you. James 4:8

1. Find an object you can throw and catch

2. Choose a partner.

If there is an odd number in your family, one person can be the judge.

3. Line up opposite each other.

(choose a distance that is too far away to begin with)

4. Throw the object to your partner.

Hopefully they can catch it!

5. Each time you throw, take a step closer to each other until eventually it is easier to catch.

6. Give each other a big hug when you catch it.

When we spend time with God, we come closer to each other. The closer we are; the easier it is to feel God's love.
